The Nunavut Planning Commission, an Institution of Public Government established under the Nunavut Agreement, invites applicants to apply for the position of Senior Planner to be located at the Commission's offices in Cambridge Bay and Iqaluit. We offer a [competitive salary, a pension plan, and benefits package, including health, dental and vision, and opportunity for career advancement.](#)

Reporting to the Manager Planning & Implementation, the incumbent is responsible for managing and providing oversight for all aspects for the effective and efficient implementation of land use plans and the Nunavut Planning and Project Assessment Act (NUPPAA). The Senior Planner's main function will be to manage the implementation of the statutory requirements of NUPPAA, oversee conformity determinations and coordinate the day to day activities of the Planners.

The ideal candidate will have a **degree in Land Use Planning or Urban Planning with a minimum of five years' experience** in formulating land use plans or implementing zoning by-laws, knowledge of the environmental assessment. A combination of education, knowledge, skills and abilities may be considered as equivalent to the formal education and experience requirements stated above.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

The applicant must have:

- Knowledge of the Nunavut Agreement
- Knowledge in Municipal Land Use Planning Law
- Work and management experience in land use planning theories and approaches regarding land use plan formulation, implementation, monitoring and evaluation
- Knowledge in formulation of procedures for standardizing the administration of a variety of land use planning services related to rezoning, plan amendments; minor variances; plan review; plan implementation, monitoring and evaluation
- Knowledge in formulating procedures for standardizing the implementation of land use planning legislation to ensure legal and operational obligations are fulfilled
- Knowledge in methods of gathering, compiling analyzing and presenting land use planning data and information
- Ability to lead and participate in work and project teams
- Advanced computer software programs for office use, the Microsoft Suite of programs, spreadsheets, statistical analysis programs
- An understanding of Geographic Information Systems and Cartographic processes would be an asset
- A wide range of Federal and Territorial regulatory processes related to the management of lands and resources
